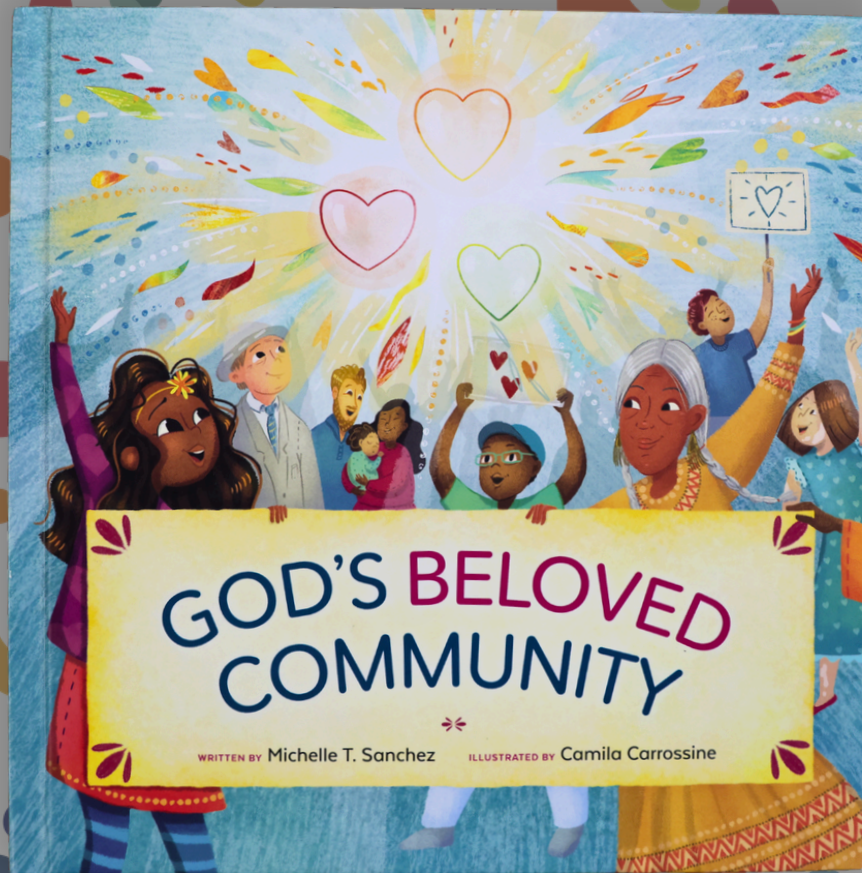

KEEP TALKING ABOUT DIVERSITY & INCLUSION
