Registration & Financial Questions

- How much does the trip cost?
 - The cost for both camps is \$535.
 - Upon registration, you'll be charged a \$150 deposit towards your total camp payment.

• Are scholarships available?

• Yes! Please fill out this form before you register for camp.

• Can I make payments over time, after paying the \$150 deposit?

 Yes! You can log into your <u>my.thecrossingchurch.com</u> account at any time and contribute money towards the trip between now and July 16th.

When is the last date to drop?

• The final day to drop out of camp is Sunday, July 9th.

• When are final payments due?

• Final payments are due on Sunday, July 16th.

Is there a mandatory camp parent meeting this year?

 Yes! Our mandatory Camp Parent Meeting is on Sunday, July 16th at 6:30 p.m. in The Crossing's auditorium. During the meeting, we will go through the logistics of drop off, pick up, and an overview of the week. There will be time at the end for questions.

Will there be a waitlist?

 Yes. We will start a waitlist immediately once camp fills. If your student is on the waitlist, we will contact you individually if a spot opens up.
